Footnotes

TYRUS chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then took over command in the stretch and drove clear late under a steady drive. DON'T GET CAUGHT dueled early from between horses, while on the inside into the turn and yielded late in the stretch run. SURF CAST was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. MOONBLAST vied early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. STORM N VIEW was back early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. FANCY TRAIN dueled early while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. TOWARD THE MARK was never a factor. PRE FONTAINE was through after a half. FLASH N CASH was done early. AMRAM had brief speed then retreated.
