STONE RUNNER set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then drew away in the stretch while in hand. BURL'S JUNIANA chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and was up for place late. TRI N SO HARD tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch run. CREPE pressed the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. RED FOR THE CURE angled into the five path in the turn while no threat. SWEET NANAPUDDIN was done early.
