CLIFF'S BEST BET set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch then came again after losing the lead to prevail in the final stages. CRAFTY SCOUT vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. TWO HONOR GLENDON chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. HIYABEN pressed the pace early from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. RAPID SURVIVOR swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. JUSTATHOUGHT angled into the four path in the turn while no threat. FINAL PITSTOP was done early. ARROSON was through after a half.
