MALIBU STORM set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, drew clear late in the stretch under a steady drive. DREYMORE chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. SHINY STAR was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch. STILETTO HEELS stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. SEJEANA'S GIFT was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn and improved position. IDE RATHER BE WILD was on the inside into the turn while no threat. TEE'S PERFECT lost irons inside the three eighth pole. ONE LADY'S VICE was through after a half. SHORT SHARP SHOT was never involved. SOCIALLY JADED showed little. COMIC DEBUT swung into the six path in the turn while no factor.
