Footnotes

WIND RIDER settled off the pace while off the inside, bid three wide near the quarter pole, moved nearest the leader outside the eighth pole and inched to the front late. FATHER JOHN vied for the lead two wide through the turn, moved to the front entering the lane, was caught by the winner inside the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. TEE'S PROSPECT bid from the four path into the lane and moved up for the minor share. LETEM FLY vied for the lead along the inside into the lane and weakened the final eighth. NEED MONEY DAD was bumped from both sides at the start, raced near the back and never threatened. FATHER ART was bumped at the start, raced behind a wall of rivals through the turn and was empty in the lane. STRAIGHT SCOOTER came widest into the lane and never factored. VERY CLEAR showed brief speed into the turn then steadily faded along the inside.
