BONO QUEEN stalked the duel early while in the three path, stayed in the three path in the far turn, drew away in the stretch under a steady drive. GULF COAST SPECIAL was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn while no match for the winner but second best. OFOUROONEOFIVE was back early, angled into the three path in the far turn, moved up in the stretch while best of the rest. ELLIE'S ANGEL dueled early from the inside, angled into the four path in the far turn and gave way readily. MOR NEWTONS PLEASE was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position. ACK CLEARLY angled into the five path in the far turn while no threat. STAMP IT GAL lunged at the start while no factor. MAID TO A TEE was done early. AUNT MADISON was never involved. MY MELODY had brief speed then retreated.
