Footnotes

JAZZ COURT chased the pace from the three path into the turn, moved closer in the latter part of the turn, caught the new leader before straightening in the lane and drove past. SIGNATURE EVENT pressed the pace three wide into the turn, bid in late turn to get the lead entering the lane and between calls then could not hold off the winner while second best. PROSPECT ROAD chased the pace from the two or three path into the lane and could not sustain the bid while clear for the show spot. B B THE KING was in the three path through the turn then moved up while not a serious threat. MYSTERIOUS NOISE was in the three or four path through the turn and moved up. COWBOY CASANOVA was never a factor while in the two or three path through the turn. SERENASGO was never a contender while off the inside into the lane. CLEAR BOARD vied for the lead two wide into late turn then gave way. WELL WHAT was outrun while coming into the lane from the five path. BAIL BONDSMAN tracked the pace along the inside and retreated. GOLD DIGGIN GROOM was outrun while near the inside. GREAT SKY DANCER battled for the early lead then quickly retreated after entering turn.
