### Footnotes

LAZ HAS RISEN chased the pace from the two path through the turn, was roused in late turn while fanning into the three path, steadily gained on the leader through the lane and just got up. SAHMMY DAVIS JR set the pace on an open lead into the lane, looked a winner outside the sixteenth pole but could not hold off his stable mate while second best. CINCO ESTRELLA was in the two path through the turn when never far back, launched a bid in mid-stretch and finished with good energy to be best of the rest. ROYALY LUCKEY raced along the inside through the turn, angled to the four path for the drive and moved up while not a serious threat. LAWYER DAGGETT chased the pace along the inside into the turn then was empty the final quarter. BRICKYARD was three wide throughout while never far back and was empty when the serious running began. BLUE RYDER RED was never a factor while in the three or four path. LIFT HIGH THE FLAG was outrun while in the two or three path. CHOW WAGON was outrun from the three path.
