Footnotes

ARCH OF TITUS was unhurried early, moved quickly through the latter part of the turn, shifted five wide into the lane and drove past the leaders just inside the eighth pole. W W DISTINCTION trailed into the turn, angled into the six path for the drive and finished willingly to gain the place spot. PASSION PARK settled off the pace, bid four wide into the lane, loomed a serious threat with an eighth to go then hung. PEYTON'S PISTOL raced along the inside through the turn, was blocked near the quarter pole, angled into the five path for the drive and slowly gained. PEARL GIRL chased the pace from the two path into the lane, gained a short lead with an eighth to go then gave way. SEATTLE EX chased the pace along the rail through the turn, was blocked entering the lane, remained without running room until about the eighth pole then had no chance. CALL M'EV'E MAYBE bid three wide into the lane and tired late. VOUCHER set the pace into the lane then gave way readily. NOBLE CYRUS was outrun from off the inside. DATEFUL GRED was finished after entering the turn while in the two or three path.
