SPEAK OF KINGS chased the two horse duel into the lane while in the two or three path, caught the leaders inside the eighth pole and drove past. BORCHETTA vied two wide into the lane, shook the dueling challenger near the sixteenth pole but was outfinished by the winner. MUSICO OSO vied for the lead along the into mid-stretch then yielded. CHOW WAGON was unharmed early while off the inside, moved through the four path into the lane and gained belatedly. EXTREME WARRIOR chased the pace from the three path into the lane and finished evenly. GOLDFINDER was along the inside into the lane and lacked a closing bid. SPEEDY MEDIA was never a threat while racing near the inside. SMOKEY THE BANDIT was through early while in the two path.
