TRICK O MAN was unhurried while well out from the inside, moved closer four or five wide through the turn, fanned five wide into the lane, caught the leader outside the eighth pole while drifting in and widened from the sixteenth on. STOCK TRADER was off a bit slow, hustled up along the inside into the turn, got through along the rail to challenge for the lead into the lane, disposed of challenger into the lane then was no match for the winner inside the eighth pole. CAPTAIN STYLES pressed the pace three wide through the turn, bid after straightening in the lane but needed more while best of the rest. MINGUN EXPRESS was six wide through the turn, fanned into the nine path for the drive and moved up while not a threat. OSCEORO set the pace into the turn, was challenged in mid-turn and into the lane and gave way. TOUGH LITTLE NUT was never a threat while near the inside. BENAMINBABINS chased the pace two wide through the turn, was steadied when tiring near the three-sixteenth pole and steadily lost ground in the lane. VICAR MOONIE RYS was in the three or four path through the turn and never factored. SHINEY SOLDIER showed brief speed along the inside and retreated. MODOC TRIBUTE was always outrun.
