Footnotes

BEG MEL was unhurried early while off the inside, quickly moved up through the four path near the quarter pole, moved four abreast into the lane, swept past the leaders outside the eighth pole and widened the final eighth. FAST EDDIE CHARLES set the pace while along the inside, was challenged through the turn, repelled one challenger, was joined by another, was keeping that one safe when quickly passed by the winner. KOKA KOLA OCEAN chased the pace from the two path through the turn, bid into the lane and could not get past the leader while holding the show spot. BEHREN'S LEGACY chased the pace along the rail into the turn, was close to the lead in mid-turn, came off the inside near the eighth pole to move to the four path and lacked the needed response. BALLACOLLA was in the three or four path into the lane and was never a serious threat. CIGAR BREAK bobbled at the start, raced near the back and never factored. CRAIG'S TYLER pressed the pace through the turn and faded entering the lane. JAMIE'S PRIDE was along the inside and was done entering the far turn. STAR VECTOR was near the rail through the turn and was finished entering the lane.
