DON'T PUT IT BACK broke in at the start, vied for the lead through the turn while two wide then gamely maintained the advantage in deep stretch while challenged by the runner-up. BANNER CAT was brushed at the start and settled off the pace, bid three wide near the quarter pole, moved closest to the winner in the lane then could not sustain the effort late. FINDING PARADISE was in the three path through the turn, gained momentum into the stretch and finished evenly. TRUE BEE was unhurried early while off the rail, bid into the lane from mid-track and had some gain while not a threat. STEVEN vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then tired. HANCHO was never a factor while near the inside. EXCLUSIVE ELUSIVE was brushed at the start, hustled up and was steadied into the turn then faded.
