ST. MAXIMUS GATO vied for the lead from between rivals through the turn, shook clear and held while being kept to the task. OUR EDGE chased the duel through the turn, moved four wide into the lane and could not gain on the winner through the final eighth while second best. I'M SO LUCKY was in the three or four path through the turn, fanned five wide for the drive and finished best of the rest while not a threat to the top two. LONESOME STORM was along the rail through the turn, angled to the four path for the drive and never threatened. TECHNIQUE was never a factor while in the three path through the turn. HELIOPSIS vied for the lead three wide through the turn then faded in the lane. MY FEVER was never a factor while near the inside. OUR ROCK STAR vied for the lead with two others into the lane then faded. MAGIC DE NASKRA was in the four path while trailing.
