Footnotes

UR UP ZIP was in the two path through the turn, moved to the four path into the lane when gaining momentum, collared the leader near the sixteenth pole and drove clear. KILLENAULE'S BEST vied for the lead two wide through the turn, repelled the dueling challenger into the lane then could not hold off the winner while second best. IDEALLY hopped at the start, raced in the three path through the turn, fanned six wide into the lane and moved up for the minor share while not a threat to the top two. WHATATA WAKI vied for the lead along the inside into the lane and was empty thereafter. PIRATE BRITTANY chased the pace three wide through the turn and tired in the drive. COWBOY REPUTATION was along the inside throughout and moved up. PRIAPUS was in the four path through the turn, came wide into the lane and never contended. TOP JOHNNY stumbled the second stride out of the gate, re-gathered and never threatened while saving ground. DANCE WITHME HENRY was three or four wide through the turn and was finished entering the lane.
