Footnotes

PREOCCUPIED was unhurried into the turn, moved four wide through the turn when gaining momentum, swept past the leaders after straightening in the lane and widened through the final eighth. NUMEN LUMEN was four wide through the first turn, moved three wide into the lane when putting pressure on the leader then was all out to save the place spot late. MR. LATONIA set the pace while near the inside, was passed in the lane and fought back to get the minor share while in a bit tight along the rail near the sixteenth pole. A ROD was jostled before entering the first turn, raced along the inside into the lane when never far back, came off the inside for the drive and missed the minor share. HIGHROLLER DAVE stalked the pace two wide through the turn, bid into the lane, led briefly before the stretch call then weakened. MIZZTERBRIAN'SLUST was never a factor while along the inside. BAIL BONDSMAN chased the pace three wide into the turn then faded. SI LA MIEL was three wide into the lane and tired.
