SUGAR SHENANIGAN'S tracked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn then got thru from the rail inside the eighth pole and drew clear in the final stages. AGHAMORA was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then rallied in the stretch and was up for place late. BELLA BABY pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but faltered late and lost place. EXCHANGING SMILES set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. GOSSIP BAY stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. TUDIE POP angled into the three path in the turn and steadily faded. KISSIN STAR was done early. LITTLE TANTRUM was through after a half. BELLING THE CAT bobbled at the start and was outrun.
