MAN FROM MARS tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then took over command and drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. KID GALAHAD was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. HIYABEN chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. PURELY AMATURE angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. POPS IS TOPS never menaced. FLYLIKABIRD set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and gave way in the stretch. SEATTLE BY THE SEA was through after a half. SIR JIM was always outrun.
