BELLAMY JONES dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid but flattened out late in the stretch run. LONG BOMB chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and weakened late. SLEW CITY BOY angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch. ELLENBERGER PARK angled off the rail into the turn and improved position. EVOLVING was never a threat. COMING ON was through after a half. DO DAT TUNE was done early.
