Footnotes

COMMANDEER settled off the pace while in the three path through the turn, bid three wide near the quarter pole, inched to the front with an eighth to go then edged clear late. BURNING TOMCAT TOM was unhurried while off the rail through the turn, gained momentum in late turn while coming three or four wide into the lane, continued with good momentum through the lane and just got up for the place spot while closing ground. HOMETOWN LEGEND vied for the lead two wide through the turn, hooked with the winner outside the eighth pole and grudgingly gave ground to that one then lost the place spot on the final nod. BIG STAGE was in the two or three path through the turn, remained in the two path into the lane when others fanned wide and made up ground to the wire. WILLPLAYNINESUNDAY vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then gave way near the eighth pole. DESERT BAY was never a serious threat along the inside. PALLASO showed speed into the turn while in the two path then tired. RIVERGUIDE was brushed after the start, raced in contention into the lane then was finished. MORE TOBE REVEALED was in the five path through the turn, floated into the eight path through the lane and finished far from the inside. ELROY J was finished early while in the three path through the turn.
