NOBLE CYRUS trailed the field early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and was just up at the wire. HERECOMESTHEMASTER chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch from the inside and just missed at the wire. TIME FOR FUN was bumped and steadied into the first turn, angled into the three path in the far turn then drew clear in the stretch but was caught late. TEXAS HOLDEM JOE was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn with a late gain in the stretch run. SUNDAY PURSUIT was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn while making a bid but weakened late in the stretch. SIR VICE ROY steadied into the first turn then raced up close early, led the field briefly, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late in the stretch drive. HUSHER angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch. LATE CHARGE was through after three quarters. BOOBY PRIZE was through after a half. CUSHION CUT had early speed then folded up. RICH AND CREAMY was done early. VALUE THE GREYBIRD was eased in the stretch.
