TAMPA'S BIG CITY chased the pace from the two path into the lane, caught the tiring leader outside the eighth pole then drove past. FAMOUS FROLIC was along the inside into the lane, moved closest to the winner inside the eighth pole then could not gain on that one. MACS ROB ROY chased the pace three wide through the turn then was clear for the show spot while finishing best of the rest. CHOCTAW BINGO lunged at the start, raced in the three path into the lane and moved up. STOP THE RACE set the pace into the lane then gave way. MAJOR ALLIANCE chased the pace three wide then lacked a bid. HUM THAT TUNE was never a factor along the inside. DEL MAR STORM was four wide through the turn, came into the lane in the seven path and was never a threat. WANNA MAKE IT was three wide through the turn, came into the lane in the six path and tired. SERVICE CORPS was pulled up before going a quarter and was vanned off.
