Footnotes

COWBOY CONTENDER chased the pace three wide through the turn, bid into the lane, caught the leaders inside the eighth pole and drove past. WALLSTREET CHARLIE stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, was moving to the leader near the eighth pole but was outfinished by the winner while being brushed inside the sixteenth pole. SPURTABILITY was along the inside throughout and got up for third while not a threat to the winner. SOLON EXPRESS set the pace from off the inside into the lane, was still clear with an eighth to go then gave way near the sixteenth pole. LOGAN TOWNSHIP was in the two or three path through the turn, moved to mid-track for the drive and moved up while not a threat. HEISWHATHEIS saved ground to no avail. CALL IN ADVANCE was in the three or four path through the turn and never factored. ZYGLOW was bumped at the start, chased the pace two wide through the turn then faded in the lane. BLAZEN HONEY was through early while in the two or three path.
