Footnotes

CECILSLUCKYMISTAKE tracked the pace along the inside into the lane, bid near the eighth pole then prevailed after a long drive. SULTRY DEMEANOR set the pace into the lane, was hooked inside the eighth pole and was slowly giving ground when drifting out late. PRAYER ANSWERED was four wide through the turn when never far back, launched a bid into the land and was closing in when bothered late when rival drifted over and took his path. JEMARU was unhurried through the turn while near the inside, came off the rail into the lane, was attempting to split rivals just inside the eighth pole when put in tight and never threatened thereafter. YABA DEVA DUE was never a factor while in the two or three path into the lane. DOUG was along the inside into the lane then lacked a response. KRUM KAKE chased the pace three wide through the turn then weakened in the drive. STAR CARSON was through after going a half from the three or four path. #8 SULTRY DEMEANOR WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND FOR INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH.
