Footnotes

BRASS BOLT vied for the lead early then took over command, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. PAWS PRINCE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished in the final stages. OAK RICH was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn with a mild gain in the stretch run. SAFARI KID was well placed early, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch. SEAPOPS trailed the field early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. TOPPER TIME was on the inside into the turn while no threat. BIGTOADINAPUDDLE angled into the four path in the turn while no factor. SIR DAKOTA was done early. LATIN NOTE showed little. UNBRIDLED DISTRESS was never involved. BOOT SCOOTIN BABY was through after a half. HIGH SKY had early speed then folded up.
