Footnotes

LORD DARBY was unhurried while off the inside, bid five wide through the turn and into the lane, caught the leader inside the eighth pole and edged clear late. SPY was unhurried early while off the inside, swept past the leaders five wide into the lane, gained the lead then could not hold off the winner. STEREO IN MOTION was unhurried while in the three path, fanned to mid-track for the drive and was gaining through the final furlong. PRETTY GOOD vied for the lead from the two path through the turn then weakened in the drive. WITCH WON WILL WIN was close up along the inside and lacked a closing response. TAHQUAMENON was in the two or three path through the turn and moved up while never a threat. RAILROAD ROY was in the five path through the turn, came widest into the lane and moved up passing tired rivals. EBEN ALSAFA pressed the pace four wide through the turn and was empty in the lane. KATIEJAKES JOURNEY was outrun while in the four or five path through the turn. CRISTOVIA vied for the lead from the three path into the turn then faded in the lane. STENSON PARK was along the inside through the turn and lost ground. SCHECTER was on the early pace, pressed the pace from the inside then retreated through the lane.
