Footnotes

LUCY RING set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew clear in the stretch under a steady drive. CREAMING was unhurried early, while on the inside into the far turn with some gain in the stretch and held place late. DR. POWERS stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn with a late gain in the stretch but missed place. GREY MIST was back early, angled off the rail into the far turn and moved up in the stretch. BABES BRIDGE IT tracked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn and faded late. ANAPPLEFORAQUEEN was done early. EXQUISITE (NZ) was through after three quarters.
