LADY IN A VEIL chased the two rival duel through the turn, shifted three wide nearing the quarter pole, moved past those two and widened under a drive. DISGRACE was in the three path through the turn and into the lane, angled to the rail inside the eighth pole and finished with good energy to be second best. INDIANA RUTH was bumped at the start, hustled to vie for the lead along the inside into the lane, put away dueling challenger after straightening but was no match for the winner and lost the place spot late. OUR PAINTED VEIL was in the three or four path into the lane and had little to give in the lane. ZIVA CAT was along the inside into the lane and moved up while never being a threat. LOREDANA angled into the six path entering the lane and never was a serious factor. ENGLISH LASS vied for the lead into the lane while two wide the gave way. MEMAWS BABY was never a factor while in the four path through the turn. ARROGANTLY SHABBY was off to an awkward start, saved ground and never menaced. SHE HOPES TO DANCE raced along the inside

into the lane and faded. NOBLE PEGASUS was finished early while in the four or five path through the turn. SAINTS ON TOP stumbled and bumped hard at the start, was well back and was eased through the lane.
