**Footnotes**

HERSILIA chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then rallied in the stretch and edged clear in the final stages. SAHMS SONG pressed the pace early from between horses, angled into the three path in the turn then took over and led in the stretch but yielded late in the drive while second best. SAKRA broke out and bumped rival at the start then stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. INAZUMA set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and gave way in the stretch run. PATTI'S WAY swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. ACTIN' UGLY was never a threat. SOCIALLY hopped at the start and was no factor. SHES DOWN WITH JIM was done early. GOODWOOD GAL tracked the pace early while three wide, fanned into the seven path in the turn and faded in the stretch. POLLARD'S BABE was bumped at the start.
