### Footnotes

GINGER MOUNTAIN tracked the pace along the inside through mid-turn, moved to the three path into the lane, caught the leader outside the eighth pole and drove past. BETTY ON TOUR chased the pace early, moved two wide to challenge for the lead into the lane, gained a short lead near the three-sixteenths pole then was no match for the winner while holding the place spot. ALI THE GREAT was in the three or four path through the turn, came into mid-track for the drive and offered a mild rally. BRASH CALICO was along the rail into the lane and never threatened. SOVEREIGN FRIEND led early then vied for the lead into the lane before fading along the rail. HAY BAYBAY HAY was close up early and between rivals approaching the turn, checked when in tight and steadily faded thereafter. WATCHER LITTLEBACK trailed throughout while off the inside.
