NEW YORK GIN broke in at the start then bumped a couple rivals, angled into the four path in the far turn then took over command and drew clear late in the stretch under a steady drive. GOLD DIGGIN GROOM was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. MY MAN PORTER tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the final stages. TWO STASH was bumped hard at the start then stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn with no late gain in the stretch run. HANDSOME HANKERS set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. JAYDEE was bumped at the start and clipped heels briefly, angled off the rail into the far turn and ran evenly in the stretch. AHORSECALLEDAN was never a threat. CHECK THIS ORDER was done early. CHARLIE'S PASSION was through after a half. AFTER A RIDERS OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF TWO STASH, NEW YORK GIN WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START
