K RUN dueled early while on the inside into the far turn then shook clear in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. BALTERSAN was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. IDE STRIKE tracked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. THE DUCK OF REED was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. WINTER FROST stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch. BREWIN AGAIN was on the inside into the far turn while no threat late. NICKERS FOR CANDY dueled early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch. G CAT was always outrun. BETONAWINNER was through after three quarters.
