Footnotes

LAUGHING CHARGE was unhurried while in the two path, was steadied near the half mile pole when in tight, remained in arrears into the lane, split rivals inside the eighth pole and finished with a rush to be up in time. STOLEN RUBIES was in the three path through the turn, moved to engage the leader inside the eighth pole, dispatched of that one inside the sixteenth pole and was opening a clear lead and was caught. PEARL GIRL set the pace into the lane, was caught in the lane, vied for the lead until inside the sixteenth pole then yielded. TROIS FAMILLE was in the five or six path through the turn, fanned widest into the lane and was gaining from mid-track. MOUNTABLE was in the three or four path through the turn and lacked a rally. JIMUDY was along the inside into the lane, bid after straightening then hung inside the eighth pole. SHE'S A DANCING was never a threat while in the three or four path into the lane. COOKIE GIRL was never a factor while in the two path. A DINK A DINK A DO was never a threat while near the inside. OURNAUGHTYESCAPADE vied for the lead, then chase the pace into the lane and faded. STE. MERE EGLISE was four wide through the turn when in good position then tired in the lane. THE LADY ISA CHAMP bolted into the first turn and was pulled up and walked off.
