Footnotes

GHAZI DUST tracked along the inside into the lane, was boxed in until just inside the eighth pole, angled out and finished with good energy to be up in time. MY MY SECRET stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, bid leaving the turn, gained a narrow advantage near the sixteenth pole then was outfinished by the winner. PHONE JOAN set the pace under pressure into the lane, still held a narrow advantage with an eighth to go then yielded inside the eighth pole. SASSY TRISHA tracked along the inside into the lane then lacked the needed response while racing along the rail. ROSE LEAVES raced off the rail into the turn,bid late in the turn then could not sustain the effort. SCOTLAND PLACE raced in the three path into the lane and lacked a response. DASHING PRINCESS was outrun from the three path. BUTTERCUP EXPRESS bid three wide through the turn then tired entering the lane. ANNIE'S RUNAWAY was outrun along the inside.
