Footnotes

PRESIDENTIAL ROSE dropped to the rail on the turn, bid from along the rail in the lane then edged to the front inside the eighth pole. TORI'S TRIUMPH chased from the three path into the lane, was on near even terms with an eighth to go then did not have enough. PATI'S PRINCESSA set the pace into the lane then weakened. JADEITE LADY swung four wide entering the lane and was never a factor. TORCH HER UP was never a factor from just off the rail. SPECTACULAR MORGAN was used early along the inside then tired. CHERRY PIE was outrun along the inside. GHAZIHASIT was outrun along the rail. L J'S ANABELL was outrun while fanning widest into the lane.
