**Footnotes**

RESPECT THE RUMORS vied three wide through the turn, gained a clear lead into the lane, looked to be home free near the sixteenth pole then was all out to last by the narrowest of margins. FINAL PITSTOP chased the pace from the three path through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive, found best foot inside the eighth pole and was quickly closing in and just missed. VERY CLEAR vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then weakened along the rail. LIL CON MAN vied for the lead between rivals into the turn, settled back off the duel and was empty in the lane. BANANA BLUES was in the four or five path through the turn, fanned widest into the lane and moved up while not a threat. GOLD RAKER was never a factor while in the three path. STORMCATSVALENTINE was never a factor while along the inside. BOSS HOSS AUSTIN was in the two or three path through the turn and never threatened. MUCH TO DO was outrun from the five path through the turn. M'NAUGHTEN tracked the duel through the turn then faded through the lane.
