Footnotes

BOSTON PROPER stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew off late under a steady drive. D'WOP D'WOP chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. POLAR ECLIPSE was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn then steadied while entering the lane and made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. PENNY'S DEPUTY was unhurried early, while on the inside into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but hung in the late stages. YARDBIRD MISFITS angled into the four path in the turn and was empty late in the stretch run. SILENT COURAGE swung into the six path in the turn and improved position. KOKOPELLI dueled early, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late in the stretch drive. NOBLE BID was never a threat. GABBAZOE set the pace for a half then folded up. PRIVATE FLYER trailed the field throughout.
