HARK stalked the pace while in the three path through the turn, bid three wide in mid-turn, moved clear after straightening in the lane and drew off. SHE'S DUE set the pace along the inside, was under pressure through the turn then was no match for the winner in the lane. MONTE CRYSTAL (PER) was in the three path into the turn, rider asked for run in mid-turn then could only gain the minor share. LADY HINKLE was along the inside into the lane and had nothing to offer. STREET SIGN went to nose at the start, raced into contention down the backstretch and lacked a response in the lane. MODEL'S MEMO chased the pace from the two path into the turn, moved to vie for the lead through the turn and was finished entering the lane. MATTER OF STYLE was through after going a half from the three path.
