SHE'S DUE FOR ONE chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn, drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared late under a steady drive. AQUA AZUL set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn, was clear in the stretch but faltered late in the stretch drive. MISS ZIGGY was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. BLUES MUSE was back early, while on the inside into the turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. APPLE PANDOWDY swung into the seven path in the turn and improved position late. BOLD PEAKS swung into the six path in the turn and faded late. HERE COMES ALEXIS was through after a half. NEVAEH'S SONG tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and soon retreated.
