MONARCA LEGACY was unhurried early while off the inside, moved four wide into the lane, hooked up with the runner-up near the eighth pole and prevailed after a strong drive. K LO'S LUCK settled off the pace while off the inside, bid three wide into the lane, was on near even terms with the winner until deep stretch and was denied after a game effort. ARRODYNAMIC vied for the lead while two wide into the lane then weakened in the final eighth. STORMY DECEPTION was along the inside throughout and was gaining the final eighth. TOWERING FOOL chased the pace along the inside into the lane and was empty. GLITTER POWER vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then gave way. CROWNFORADAY was never a factor near the inside. GOOD TIMING was in the four path through the turn and was never in it. SEEYOUINAHUMMER was outrun while in the three path through the turn. DO WORK SON dwelt at the start, trailed into the lane and broke down outside the eighth pole.
