Footnotes

HELL SPIKE set the pace from the two path into the turn, repelled challenger entering the lane and widened through the final eighth. RODS RUNNING REDD was along the inside through the turn, cut the corner and finished with good energy to be second best while not a threat to the winner. WIN DOUGH REID was bumped at the start and settled back, moved quickly through the turn and three wide into the lane then flattened inside the eighth pole and just held the show spot. I SEE A SHARK was well back and in the two or three path through the turn, gained momentum into the lane and weaved through traffic while moving up and missing the show spot. PASS THE CROWN made a bold move four wide into the lane then flattened out the final eighth. WIN RICH AFFAIR pressed and vied for the lead two wide through the turn and faded in the lane. HUNTINGTON'S BEST tracked the pace along the inside into the lane, had an open rail but was empty. TITANIUM STAR was never a factor while saving ground. SIR RUDY was done after traveling a half from the three path. IMAGE MAKER was outrun from near the inside. INTERCEPTED stumbled at the start, bumping rival, raced in the four path through the turn and steadily lost ground.
