**Footnotes**

ASTAIRE chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then split horses entering the lane and drew off late in the stretch under a steady drive. MAGICAL PARK stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn while making a bid but was no match for the winner late in the stretch. QUEBEC CITY set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then faltered late in the stretch. CLASSICAL RHYTHM was squeezed early and trailed the field, while on the inside into the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. ITS MR. CAT TO YOU tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. PROSICO pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. BOOGIEMANBALL was done early.
