**Footnotes**

PAVO DANCER settled early while off the rail, moved four wide approaching the lane, fanned into mid-track for the drive and drove clear. OUR ACCIPITER vied along the inside into the lane, repelled challenger entering the turn then was no match for the winner while saving the place. OAK RICH raced in the three or four path through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive and moved up for the minor share. DR. BLUE GROOM chased the pace from the three path into the lane then weakened. KOA raced along the inside into the lane then lacked a response. DEERHOUNDS DIESEL tracked the pace along the inside and tired in the lane. STAGE DOOR BILL was in the three or four path through the turn and moved up while never a threat. OLE CAPPY was never a factor while in the two or three path. MORO PROSPECTOR vied for the lead two wide into the lane then faded. BUBBLE GUM JACK was outrun from the three path. ISSYORNOT was outrun along the inside.
