SPEEDY MEDIA was unhurried early, fanned into the six path in the turn then rallied in the stretch then drove past late under a brisk drive. PEACE AND JOY tracked the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn then led late in the stretch but couldn't last in the later stages. NESTLE IS QUICK was well placed early, angled off the rail into the turn and ran evenly late. CHOSEN CHIEF chased the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and lacked a late bid. SECRET VOW swung widest into the lane with a mild gain in the stretch. ALL STAR LOVER raced up close early, angled into the six path in the turn with no late gain. ARTILLERY MAN dueled early then took over the lead, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. DOCALOT dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way readily.
