HARD LUCK MONK vied for the lead early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch with a long drive and prevailed late. BUSTER ROSE pressed the pace from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. FATHER MICK chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. PICO SUAVE angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. SPY GAME set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch. PORT ROYAL TEE was through after a half. POPS IS TOPS was always outrun. MAJOR POINT was never involved. SPENCERS CHOICE showed little.
