Footnotes

ANA KENA set the pace on a clear lead from the outset, widened into the turn and through the lane while being kept to the task. MARIANNE CAN stalked the winner two wide down the backstretch and through the turn then lacked a closing response while clearly second best. PRETTY PAULINE was unhurried early while off the rail, moved into the lane from the four path and improved position to be best of the rest. HAV LOTA FAITH was in the three path through the turn and lacked a closing response. ALI THE GREAT was along the inside and moved up through the lane and never threatened. WHATATA HOOSIER chased the pace along the inside into the turn then faded in the lane. COLADA LOVE was never a factor from off the inside. ACCORDINGLY ANN was outrun while coming into the lane from the six path. MY GIRL PATTY was done entering the turn from the two or three path. MY FLASHY TETON chased the pace from the three path into the turn and retreated near the three-eight pole. LONG TALL JANE was finished early while racing very wide and was subsequently vanned off. BAYOU SUNSET done after a half and dropped back and was subsequently eased through the lane.
