POPULIST POLITICS stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn then drove past the leader in the stretch and cleared the field late. P D Q KIDDO dueled early, angled into the three path in the far turn then weakened in the stretch while no match for the winner. UNREACHABLE STAR was well placed early, angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch run. HOOSIER KINGDOM tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. CINCO ESTRELLA was never a factor. MEADOW WISE dueled early then folded up in the stretch.
