TWILIGHT ECLIPSE trailed the field early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn then split horses inside the sixteenth pole and drove past the leader in the final stages. INTERNALACCOUNTING stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. WHAT A LOOSECANNON tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch. MAN FROM MARS pressed the pace early then led the field briefly, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. STEAMBOAT STEVE set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. SLEW CITY BOY was through after a half.
