REGO WARRIOR was unhurried early while in the four or five path, fanned into mid-track for the drive, continued to move farther out while leader drifted and got up late. MAX'S PICTURE THAT vied three wide through the turn, gained a clear lead with an eighth to go then drifted out and was desperate late and could not hold. ITSA HOLIDAY chased the pace three or four wide into the lane then was gaining late. HONKY TONK GOLD trailed through the turn, fanned widest into the lane, looked hopelessly beaten inside the sixteenth pole when the leaders tired and closed the gap late. IAIN'TMADATCHA chased the pace while in the two path into the lane, had an open run through the lane and lacked a bid. BRASS BOLT vied from between rivals into the lane then lacked the needed response. WEST ON WALLSTREET chased the pace from the three path into the lane and tired. JACKS ARE LUCKY vied for the lead from the inside into mid-turn then dropped back.
