Footnotes

BURNING BUSH vied along the inside through the turn, disposed of challenger entering the lane and drew off and was kept to the task to the end. RIP AND ROLL vied for the lead two wide through the turn, was no match for the winner into the lane and finished second best. PEACE MON was along the rail throughout and gained the show spot in the final sixteenth while no threat to the top two. IKE'S BOY chased the pace from the three path through the turn, bid into the lane, looked a threat for the place spot inside the eighth pole then flattened out. KNOWS HOW TO ROCK was in the three or four path into the lane and never factored. CONTROL THE DICE was well back while trailing the field, fanned widest into the lane and never menaced. DEFENSIVE FLIP steadily faded along the rail. DEVILS WAY was done after traveling a half from the three or four path.
